Minutes:

- Annual Town Report will be updated to reflect new CPC members (Jill and Pierre)
- Michael Moser discussed awarded collaborative planning grant of \$13,770 for planning activities for Cambridge and Jeffersonville.
- The grant will allow setting up some community input meetings and a written survey for collecting data from residents on what they think our town needs as far as infrastructure, what the challenges are, and any other problems that may need to be addressed.
- Mapping the two village centers will also be part of the activities this grant will cover. Per Mary Paulman, the geographic mapping for both villages is already done. Municipal mapping is also already available for Jeffersonville, but maybe not for Cambridge village center. Regardless, both villages will benefit from a mapping update through this grant. Municipal mapping is also required if this grant will be used to apply for "Village Center" designation for one or both of the villages. Research may be needed to determine if existing boundaries are to stay or move.
- Future community input meetings will be announced at the next town meeting as part of the agenda. The goal is to have 4 input meetings for Jeffersonville, and 4 for Cambridge. Anyone can attend either. Potential locations discussed are CES for Jeffersonville meetings, the America Legion or Brown & Jenkins coffee for Cambridge.
- Two sandwich boards will be purchased using the awarded planning grant to announce various activities in the villages including the community input meetings.

Action Items:

- Michael Moser to advise Mark Gates of Cambridge Village Trustees of awarded planning grant and what we are thinking of doing with it. Michael also to seek Mark's advice and suggestions on what he'd think we could use it for.
