Dana Sweet, Chair – opened the meeting at 6:30

The clerk read the letter from Jacalyn Diesenhouse.

C.J. Manchester made the motion to abate; Cora Conly seconded, so voted.

7:00 p.m. meeting with Lamoille County Rail Trail
Laird MacDowell and Zeke Zucker

All Act 250 permits are in place. There is nothing to inhibit the project.

Danville to St. Johnsbury – Bridge – first phase.

Cambridge Junction to Center of Morrisville – we are in the middle part of phase I.

There is a letter from Al Robertson (see attached).

Construction costs will be done by VAST.

They want services -- other towns in County are giving materials and time. They want Alan Audette to bush hog twice a year. Need a place to store equipment while building the park.

Zeke Zucker said every five miles they have to have a trail head. One by Poland Bridge, Jeffords Park. VTrans runs from Bridge down to Ray Salomey's garage. They need a Browns field assessment.

Three things – park – Smuggs wants a building and VAST wants a building for the groomer. Need a lease - not a non-profit status – They want the town to check on insurance.

David Vaughan wondered about liability. Jane will ask Town & Country.

Larry Wyckoff said they could work with them, just need more information.

Next meeting to be held on January 7th. Would like to have the Fire Department in.

Would also like to have Library and Rescue in with budgets.

Police contract – 50 hours. Larry Wyckoff made the motion to keep the State Police hours the same and at the same rate as last year. David Vaughan seconded – so voted.
