Meeting of June 17, 2013

Present: David Vaughan – Chair, Dana Sweet, Larry Wyckoff
Jane Porter – Clerk, David Severance – Cambridge Rescue

David Vaughan opened the meeting at 6:30 and turned it over to David Severance

David S was in on the update to the emergency plan. There are blank forms there – next year a small plan. Added – Mary Elizabeth School as high risk.

Law enforcement in charge with Fire and Rescue – search and rescue –

Rescue is now licensed paramedic.

David Severance says that rescue, fire and police work well together. David Vaughan asked about personnel. David S said down to 13 people. They are going to hire a part-time person. They will advertise.

Larry Wyckoff asked how they track the town allocation – separate books? David Severance said yes. David is concerned about Hipa

Fund raising account – 90% goes for equipment.

Check on bonding for listers.

24 hours a week / part time

Give the number of gallons used to fire, rescue, and school buses

Vehicle insurance would be cheaper with town, rescue and fire vehicles all together.

The clerk will check to see if the town will check on gas and oil prices

David Severence said next year's budget will go up.

Mike Lapointe was in from NRCS (Natural Resource Conservation Services). Mike had gotten a call from Victor Veve – river went out of channel. The head of his NRCS cannot declare disasters because of sequester. In Irene spent 6 million

Protect stream beds

Victor applied for private donations from Irene Fund. NRCS can't work with individual. They need a sponsor – the town would be the sponsor.

75% - 25%

Irene was 90% – 10%

NRCS agreement would be with the town. – going to restore the channel – Chris Brunnel has ok'd it

Dana Sweet wants wash out by the culvert included. It is already done – can't get paid back.

Chris Brunnel said go in and make repairs to put it back where it was. VT Disaster Relief Fund – private – money left from Irene will go to other events.

Estimate – excavate and truck away 351 yards rip rap

3500 is 25% of Veve's damage.

Mike Lapointe will look at Bridge #44

Correction – Bonnie brought up about gravel pit

David severance said Red Cross has picked Cambridge as a pilot project – shelter – cots, blankets and place to store them. David said we do not have a place.

Dana Sweet made the motion to adopt emergency plan; Larry Wyckoff seconded – so voted.

Larry Wyckoff made the motion to accept the June 3rd minutes, David Vaughan seconded, so voted.
Larry Wyckoff made the motion to accept the June 5th minutes, Dana Sweet seconded, so voted.

David Vaughan made the motion to send town excavator to dig test holes at the Jefford's; Dana Sweet seconded – so voted.

Larry Wyckoff asked if the town could put gravel past Kevin Hanley's garage and near the Sunrise Physical Therapy building. There are some large pot holes.

Fire Station

Larry Ruggles was back – did not finish – need to come back and paint – to do spring punch list walk through

Fund Raising account is putting \$5000 for insulated shades – Larry Wyckoff wants \$5000 more from the fire station account.

July 1st meeting – hearing on sidewalk and lighting grant.

David Vaughan made the motion to adjourn at 8:35, seconded; so voted.
