David Vaughan opened the meeting at 6:30 pm

Larry Wyckoff wants an article for the actual construction

David Vaughan wondered about doing it without the study (scoping)

Don Lange said go to the Town after scoping and see what people want. We need an engineer for the construction. Asked about the size of grants. Jay Allen said 4 million for the State this year.

Jay Allen will get Rick Westman and Bernie Juskiewicz involved.

Larry Wyckoff asked about the maintenance. Jay Allen said the town. The Town says the Village takes care of water, sewer and sidewalks. Bill Sander says the Village takes care of the water, sewer, and sidewalks.

Jay Allen said the Village will have to write a letter saying the Village will take care of the maintenance.

Larry Wyckoff moved \$3,500 for scoping grant for sidewalks to the Village and the maintenance will be left to the Village. Dana Sweet seconded, so voted. Letter stating the Town agrees to pay up to \$32,500 for 10% for VTRANS bicycle and pedestrian grant.

Dana Sweet asked about the water pipes on the Upper Valley Road. The Village Trustees said it would be two years to install the new pipes on Upper Valley Road.

The Clerk (Jane Porter) said Ed O’Leary said no to the proposed “Welcome To Cambridge” sign in the Notch on the town line.

The Select Board supported Adam Howard in getting the “Welcome to Cambridge”

Larry Wyckoff brought up about burning trash. Board will write a letter to the people burning.

Joe Rogers has resigned from the Cemetery Commission. The Board accepts his resignation regretfully.

Dana Sweet wants to know if Vergennes and New Haven exempt the solar array. Larry Wyckoff made the motion not to exempt the solar array; Dana Sweet seconded, so voted.

Request for New Street Name – Preston Randall. Dana Sweet made the motion to adopt Timshel Drive, Larry Wyckoff seconded; so voted.

Clerk brought up about Rescue audit. Donna Hutchins and Bonnie Hitchcock wanted to know what the Board wanted. They would prefer to audit at the Rescue office. The Board would like it done by September.

Larry Wyckoff moved to adjourn at 7:40; Dana Sweet seconded, so voted.
