David Vaughan opened the meeting at 6:30.

Doug Grey wanted to know where the town, state, village would like him to put snow that is in front of the bank, store, church, Tink Kittel's and around the corner.

Dana Sweet asked if there was an issue where the snow went.

Lucille Brooker said it went better last winter but she had a hole in her lawn. She would like a sign and a parking space near the ramp declaring it handicap parking.

Bill Morey said it depends on the storm when he can get it cleaned on Main Street.

Don Lange said Howard Callihan clears it for the Village.

Dana wants Doug Gray to continue as he has. Doug will take care of Lucille's in front.

Adam Howard said all businesses should be treated the same.

Larry Wyckoff said the town would monitor it.

Adam would like delineated parking in the Village.

Adam thought that if Bernie and Richie pushed the State, it would happen.

Don Lange asked about towing.

Bill Morey said they don't touch 108.

Doug Flagg and Gen Brieterbach (Bourne Road) – paving done by the Town last week – no notification that it was going to happen.

They own 14 feet from building out – they are renovating their house. They feel it is devalued by this action. There will be flooding and no drainage put in. Doug would like his 14' back – he has been encroached on. Septic is under the road.

Dana read the deed – Dana said everyone owns to the middle of the road – it is a common right of way for everyone.

Overweight truck situation. 16,000 lbs. They are all over weight. Larry Wyckoff and Bill Morey said the town trucks can't back out on to Route 15. Bill Morey said they tried to keep it from eroding – they had it curved up.

Dana Sweet wants Dick Sargent to read the deeds and get his interpretation. They will get it resolved. They do not want to lose any more of this property. Dana Sweet said they cannot do anything about the trucks overweight permits. Doug Flagg mentioned the signage.

David Jones (Town Constable) was in -- he has been asked about four wheelers on back roads. David Vaughan said if they have agricultural plates they can go on back roads. David Vaughan wants an ordinance for four wheelers with speed limits. Larry Wyckoff said it would be needed to be voted on at town meeting.
