David Vaughan asked Steve how Rescue is going and how many people they have. Full member has 48 hours a month - they are 12 full time; three Associate members at 36 hours/month. Two people from Smugglers Notch are taking courses. One is on leave of absence. One leave of absence.

Tried 30 scenarios

End result – Route 15

RR bridge is hindering How can we bring flood levels down

1. RR bridge – raise it more than water would go through
