December 2, 2013 – Select Board Meeting

Present: David Vaughan – Chair, Dana Sweet, Larry Wyckoff – Select Board

Sergeant Cooper and Lt. Whitcomb – State Police

David Vaughan opened the meeting at 6:30 pm.

David Vaughan said averaging 42-46 hours per week. Sgt. Cooper went through the months. David Vaughan thanked them for the good job they are doing.

Larry Wyckoff asked if this station is working out ok. Sgt. Cooper said they appreciate it.

David Vaughan asked if next year's contract would be the same. Dana Sweet asked if we were the only ones in Lamoille County that had a contract. Sgt. Cooper said yes.

Sgt. Cooper asked if the Board wanted to change the hours, the Board said no, they still want 50/hours per month.

Larry Wyckoff said the roundabout is working – the traffic is slower. Stop sign in the intersection.

Call Jim Smith to talk to Sgt. Cooper. Check on State Police income and disbursements. Cell # for Sgt. Cooper – 595-1696

Steve Trala – Cambridge Rescue – was in. He said they had 18-19 members and by summer would be 26. He brought in his budget for 2014. Said they had hired a part-time person for every Saturday and one other day – he is an EMT. Asking for \$55,000 from the Town. Calls are down right now. Need cables for the back of defibrillators. Two hand held @ \$870 each. Dana Sweet made the motion to buy; Larry Wyckoff seconded – so voted.

David Vaughan made the motion to pay \$20,000 toward the soil contamination loan from the fire station account; Larry Wyckoff seconded, so voted.

David Vaughan made the motion to have Douglas Babcock serve as Emergency Management Director for the Town; Larry Wyckoff seconded – so voted.
