Meeting of January 20, 2014

Present: David Vaughan – Chair, Dana Sweet, Larry Wyckoff – Select Board  
Jane Porter, Clerk  
Hazel Carpenter, Terry Carpenter

David Vaughan opened the meeting at 6:15.

Hazel Carpenter had two questions:

Hazel and Terry Carpenter heard they have 16 people but not enough to cover 24/7. They asked if Steve Trala was there all the time. Also, who trained the people? She was told the driver did not live in town and had only been to the Fletcher Allen once.

Larry Wyckoff said we do not have enough people. Hazel asked when we would have to turn it over to someone else. Dana Said NEMS and Fairfax also need help. Dana would like 24/7 coverage. Dana said he had asked Steve – Steve said we need people not more money. . Larry Wyckoff said we don't give them a large appropriation. Hazel asked if NEMS could come in and buy the ambulance service. None of the Board thinks they could cover. If we have day calls, we have mutual aid. Terry said the residents think they are covered but the town isn't. Terry said there were a lot of mistakes. Hazel asked if that

wouldn't be a time to call the fire department for a driver and two in the back. Terry said he would contemplate driving another time. Dana said it takes a long time to train somebody. David Vaughan said we are doing everything we can to help them.

Terry McCuin – Rescue building – he had received two bids for painting. David McCauley - \$2500 total to begin in May; Guy Smitters - \$4600 Total. There is mildew in the building. Had received two estimates for the windows – Ace Glass - \$9800; Ray's Home and \_\_\_ \$10,600 (change doors and windows – does not include painting. Terry said they would be good for ten years. Still have roofing and furnace room issues. The Board said David McCawley got painting contract.

Larry Said \$3500 for air exchanger. Article for \$20,000 for rescue building – not to exceed \$20,000

Alan Cary and Carey White were in for the Fire Department.  
Proposed budget \$131,900.00 \$6000 Fletcher contract  
Beginning balance - \$10,688.52  
Town Appropriation -- \$115,211.48 (2014) -- up from \$108,143.60 (2013)

Said they are having trouble with heating system.

David Vaughan asked if the Fire Department could help rescue with drivers. Alan Cary said this is touchy. Larry Wyckoff said they will try to help.

Larry Wyckoff asked about plans on a tanker – will put a committee together -- lucky if it holds together for the next year. Larry said looking at a poly body. No article this year.

David Vaughan thanked the fire department for their help during the ice storm.

Conservation Commission – Justin Marsh, Don Lange

Don Lange – wants to make children aware of conservation.

Trails -- \$1,000 – link from Greenway to Windridge trails – access through John Dunne's property to Robtoy Road. Improve signage on Greenway and Windridge Trails and Matt Mutts from the Greenway.

Larry Wyckoff said question last meeting – separate Greenway -- total budget \$4250.
