Select Board Meeting – May 5, 2014

Present: Larry Wyckoff – Chair, Dana Sweet, David Vaughan – Select Board
Jane Porter, Clerk

Larry Wyckoff opened the meeting at 6:30

Sgt. Cooper was in – talked about signs – intersection by Church and 108 South.
Dana boost up coverage between 2:30 and 3:30 pm by Mary Elizabeth School.
They are covering Upper and Lower Valley Roads and 104. David Vaughan thinks they are doing a great job.

Dana Sweet made the motion to send two letters on speed reduction on 109 and 108 South. David Vaughan seconded – so voted. Sargent Cooper talked about the ordinance changes.

Approved Minutes – Meeting of May 5, 2014

Dana Sweet made the motion to approve the minutes of April 21; David Vaughan seconded – so voted.

Bob Eccles – Health Officer was in concerning Dan Reynolds Drive. Difficult to get in there and turn around. He goes once a year about trash – 25 - 30 bags. Bob and Select Board do not think it is health issue.

Muriel McCuin – Lister was in. Listers would like mileage raised from .50 to \$1.00. They go to every single property each fall – cars get scratched, tires punctured, bottom out, lost an exhaust system. They are looking for \$1.00 per mile. They contacted three companies for a rental for nine weeks in the fall season. Federal pays .56 a mile; listers getting .50 mile. \$1.00 a mile for one year. Dana Sweet made the motion to increase mileage rate for the listers from .50 to \$1.00; David Vaughan seconded – so voted.

Larry Wyckoff said he sent a letter to Paul Costello regarding the Community Visit Program.

Larry said hydrant at Business Park froze – problem with drain in the bottom. Fire Department has applied for a dry hydrant at Smugglers View -- \$4,000. Fire Department put in for \$10,000.

The Board will fix the one at the Business Park. Select Board is applying for a grant for \$10,000 – we will fix the hydrant for \$2,000 – now 25% grant for dry hydrants.
