Meeting of August 4, 2014

Meeting opened at 6:39 pm.

Present: Larry Wyckoff – Chair, Dana Sweet, David Vaughan – Select Board  
Jane Porter – Clerk  
Hazel Carpenter

Dana Sweet made the motion to adopt minutes of July 23<sup>rd</sup>; David Vaughan seconded – so voted.

Hazel Carpenter in concerning Cambridge Rescue and how it was doing.

Larry Wyckoff said they are doing better – membership is now 21; 4 part-time people; 10 live out of town. Have more on the schedule; fewer holes in the calendar.

Hazel wants to look into farming rescue out. Hazel asked who is responsible for rescue. Larry said they are incorporated, we don't hire or fire. Larry told Hazel he would get the number of missed calls. Hazel would like more coverage.

Next meeting – September 8<sup>th</sup>. Steve Trala will be in with budgets, policies, etc. Hazel to attend.

Jean Yankaskus was in. She and \_\_\_\_\_ are going to raise their home. Grant is due on August 5<sup>th</sup> and the town needs to be the applicant. 25% funding which Jean will assume (\$40,000). Bonnie Waninger said her chances are great to get it – this is Irene money.

David Vaughan made the motion to be the lead applicant for the grant, Dana Sweet seconded, so voted.

Bonnie Waninger and Rob Moore (LCPC) to talk about the park and ride . Rob met a site – checked with VTrans, District \_\_\_\_\_ If the State makes \_\_\_\_\_ investment – they want it \_\_\_\_\_ and storm water done – curbs. He wants to do it in phases – do some grading and get rid of puddles – they want it all done.

Bottom line – town can spread gravel \_\_\_\_\_. They will ask for money \_\_\_\_ State will probably pay for all of it, but town puts money up front. David asked if Jim Smith could do the engineering. Larry Wyckoff will talk to GW Tatro to get an estimate on grading and expanding - won't be bus ready yet. Need an informal sketch. Bonnie suggested talking with CTA about plowing it – Bonnie wants a contract for help on flood plain plan for the town and Village of Cambridge. Bill Morey asked about Bartlett Hill; they will try.

Double culvert under Route 15 – one under roundabout – Tatro's to distillery – Joinery and auto shop (4x8).

Adv. – cost \$500,000 / 25% \$125,000 Is this a project.

Dana can't picture doing this pay \$125,000, VTrans, Village and Town together and see how it can work. The Board said it is a state highway. Dana thinks we need to address other water issues – behind Aubuchon's

Bonnie asked if they are in support of the project – the Board said yes. Would town be applicant or co-applicant. Dana asked Bonnie if Village or Town should be co-applicant – Town – the Board will support it.

Larry Wyckoff asked about the bridge – will be \_\_\_\_\_ years for bridge replacement.

Bonnie will notify the Board about meeting with VTrans.

Doug Babcock (Emergency Management Director) was in. \_\_\_\_\_ FEMA reimbursement will be less until our ordinance is revised.
