Meeting opened at 6:30

David Vaughan made the motion to accept the minutes of April 6th, Larry Wyckoff seconded – so voted.

Dana asked Richard to present his concerns on the Pumpkin Harbor Road. Richard had done much research on the subject. He presented pictures of the culverts that had been capped. Paul S asked about water. Larry W explained the displacement of water. Paul S asked who would give the green light – Dana said Chris Brunelle (State engineer). Dana said if we raised it three (3) feet town would have to buy property. Dana will get Chris there and have whoever wants to be there.

Paul S wants a committee so there can be an extra set of ears and eyes. Dana said Chris has a three (3) person board over him.
