Dana Sweet opened the meeting at 6:30

The motion was made and seconded to accept the minutes of May 18<sup>th</sup> – so voted

Larry Wyckoff said they had talked to Blittersdorf (All Earth's Renewables), Green Lantern and Aegis concerning the solar field on Stebbins Road. Blittersdorf was the only one that would invest in getting three-phase power.

Solar at the capped landfill – Green Lantern is interested – we would have to clear some land.

Landfill would have  
one-half mega watt  
Larry said twenty acres available (3-4 megawatt potential)

Smugglers Notch would buy the power.

Larry Wyckoff said we will bring it before the voters.

Blittersdorf wants an option to lease, and then they can go to Vermont Electric.

Kim Hayden a representative from Downs Rachlin and Martin was in on an advisory capacity concerning the solar project. She had several questions concerning the lease of the land to Blittersdorf and potential purchase of the solar field in five years. The town landfill solar project was also discussed.

Several questions were asked by the Select Board and decided that more research is needed. The Select Board asked her to look into these concerns. She would also be working with Roger Prescott on the tax issues. Brian Albarelli had concerns about selling the land vs. leasing. The Select Board suggested that the finance committee along with Brian Albarelli look over the information. They will get back with us soon.
