Dana Sweet opened the meeting at 6:30 pm

Board of Abatement – Steve Clokey had written a letter asking that the penalty on his delinquent tax bill be abated because he had not received the tax bill. Bill Sander asked if there was an attorney. Steve C said yes – Fred Peet. There was confusion on the tax year and many confusing things at the closing. His attorney had told him to check with the clerk on taxes. After much discussion Bill Sander made the motion to not abate the penalty; Jan Sander seconded. After more discussion, Larry Wyckoff made the motion to table the abatement until February 1st so Steve could talk with his lawyer concerning the taxes, Dana S seconded – so voted.

The Board of Civil Authority was asked to approve the list of new voters and transferred voters --- Sally R explained that there is a new voter registration system in the State and would check over the list to make sure all new registrations were on the list. Ron Elliott made the motion to accept the list as presented, seconded – so voted.

Dana Sweet presented Bob Eccles with a plaque recognizing his many years as the Town Health Officer.

Seth Jensen – Lamoille County Planning Commission – was in on the grant for Bartlett Hill. UVM engineering program possible to use them to do preliminary engineering work done it would be compelling – it would raise awareness of the program – next year is a better position for a grant.

Dana asked about getting trees and gravel out of the water near the bridge so the water would flow better.

One option – remote sensing – gets down to two foot contours.

Bridge – Larry said the town would pay \$2,000 for the study. Two culverts between Tatros and roundabout.

Dana asked about a traffic study in Cambridge concerning getting a cross walk.

Fire tanker bid – Larry Wyckoff made the motion to accept the bid of \$4,500 – Dana Sweet seconded – so voted.

Dana Sweet made the motion to adjourn at 7:45, seconded so voted.
