

The inhabitants of the Town of Cambridge, who are legal voters in the Town School District meeting of said Cambridge, respectively, are hereby notified and warned to Town School District meeting at the Cambridge Memorial Gymnasium in Jeffersonville within said Town on Tuesday, March 1, 2016 at seven o'clock in the forenoon, eastern standard time, to vote by Australian ballot on the following article:

Article I: Shall the voters of the Cambridge Elementary School District approve the school board to expend \$5,866,651, which is the amount the school board has determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year? It is estimated that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in education spending of \$13,815.77 per equalized pupil. This projected spending per equalized pupil is 3.29% higher than spending for the current year.

The legal voters of Cambridge Town are further notified that voter qualification, registration and absentee voting relative to said annual meeting shall be provided in Chapters 43, 51 and 55 of Title 17, Vermont Statutes Annotated.

The legal voters of the Town of Cambridge are further notified that an informational meeting will be held at the Cambridge Elementary School in Jeffersonville on Wednesday, February 24, 2016 at 6:00 o'clock in the evening (p.m.) and for the purpose of explaining the proposed 2016-2017 school budget.

Notice is hereby given that the ballot box for such budget vote of the Town School District shall open at seven (7) o'clock in the forenoon on Tuesday, March 1, 2016 and will close at seven (7) o'clock in the evening.

- Art. 11. In Town School District Meeting to elect by ballot for the following Director's Terms:
1. Cambridge School District School Director for two (2) years;
 2. Cambridge School Director School Director for three (3) years; and
 3. Lamoille Union School District School Director for three (3) years.
- Art. 12 Shall the voters of the Cambridge Town School District authorize the School Directors to borrow money to pay current expenses and debts of said District in anticipation of the collection of taxes?
- Art. 13 To hear and discuss the report of the Lamoille North Supervisory Union Act 46 committee. No action to be taken.
- Art. 14 Will the Town authorize the Select Board to acquire by gift or purchase, land for a municipal forest, to produce wood products, maintain wildlife habitat, protect water supplies, provide forest recreation, for conservative education and other purposes?
- Art. 15 Will the Town in Town Meeting vote to authorize the Select Board to spend not more than \$25,000 to do a feasibility study for an addition to the Rescue Building?

Art. 16 Will the Town of Cambridge in Town Meeting and Town School District Meeting vote to exempt the Green Mountain Aerie #3210 F.O.E. property for a period of five years?

Art. 17 Will the Town vote to expend from its funds a sum in addition to the amount required by law, to take advantage of benefits of the State Aid laws and Regulations of the Department of Highways relating to the maintenance fund and any and all other similar acts which may be available during the year by the State?

Art. 18 Will the Town vote to raise money on its Grand List for the year 2015 to pay debts and current expenses of the Town, and if so, determine the amount thereof in dollars, the time and manner in which the same shall be payable?

Art. 19 To do any other business that may legally come before said Town Meeting and said Town School district Meeting.
