

Community Visit: Senior Taskforce

October 12, 2016

1. Wii: Don reported that Kate McCuin had looked into the Rec Board's delivery of the Wii to the residents of Mann's Meadow. Fred W gave it to George G who delivered it to Mann's Meadow. Nanci Lepsic volunteered to follow-up.
2. Senior Luncheon:
 - a. It will be held on Wednesday, November 9 at the Jeffersonville Congregational Church. The lunch will be from 11:00 – 1:00. Members of the taskforce can use the site from 10:00 – 2:00. We are planning for 40 - 50 people to attend.
 - b. Food: Don and Betsy will solicit local grocery stores for meat, cheese, tomatoes, lettuce, bread, butter, and cider. April will provide the coffee, creamer, and sugar. Elisha will bring the condiments. If Elisha has not asked local restaurants to provide soups, Denice and Nanci are willing to make them. Everyone will make desserts.
 - c. Plates, etc.: Nanci will purchase the take-out containers, plates, napkins, cups, forks, knives, and spoons.
 - d. Presenter: Bernie J will present an analysis of the results of the state elections.
 - e. Publicity: Betsy will create the fliers as well as post the announcement on Front Porch Forum. Jeanne will print them so they are in color. Everyone will distribute the fliers.
 - f. Rides: Betsy will speak with the Town Clerk's Office to have them handle the sign-up sheets. She will ask Smuggs if they are willing to provide a van. Those in need of a ride, will have to sign up by Monday, November 7.
3. The Village Network, Inc.: April reported that the Select Board approved the allocation of \$150 to purchase the starter materials for the program. Jeanne and April will meet to review next steps and update the taskforce. We discussed asking the Town to earmark some funds for the project. April will follow-up. Nanci raised the idea of including community transportation as part of the project.
