

Selectboard Rules of Procedure

PROCEDURES FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

Procedures for public comment shall be reviewed at the beginning of all meetings.

The chair of the Selectboard, or in the chair's absence, the vice-chair, shall chair all Selectboard meetings. Questions of order or procedure may originate only from the board. Comments from the public, indicated by show of hand, may be recognized with permission of the chair and are directed to the chair.

At the beginning of each Selectboard meeting, there shall be 5 minutes of total time afforded for open public comment. This time is not to be used for discussion of non-agenda items.

Public comment on agenda issues may be offered during the meeting with the permission of the chair. Such comment, if permitted, shall be limited to 5 minutes of total time.

Selectboard Rules of Procedure shall be made available at all meetings.
